Dear Jane,

Please accept this letter as California's formal request to extend two existing waivers for an additional ninety (90) day period. The current waivers are due to expire on September 30, 2011.

The first waiver continues the use of the Work Readiness Indicator as the only indicator of performance for youth who participate in summer youth employment activities that utilize Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) and are co-enrolled in Workforce Investment Act (WIA) youth activities.

The second waiver extends the program design flexibility to serve these same youth who participate in summer employment activities that utilize TANF funds and are co-enrolled in WIA funded youth activities.
